

Admission Rules and Procedure for Academic Session 2025-26

The applications are invited from eligible candidates who are willing for admissions in the various courses offered in the Constituent Colleges and Teaching Department of the University as per the admission guidelines and procedure laid down by the competent authority of Chirayu University, Bhopal.

The step-by-step admission process applicable for the following Faculties of University is given below:

- A. All programmes offered by University UTDs i.e. BBA, MBA, MHA, B.Tech.- CSE(Comp. Sc & Engg.) B.Tech.- CSE (AI & ML), B.Tech.- CSE (Data Science), B.Tech.- CSE (Cyber Security), M.Tech.- CSE, BPES, MPES, B.A., M.A., B.Com, M.Com.
- B. M.Sc. programme offered by Faculty of Medicine.
For other programmes (MBBS, MD/MS), the admission process will be as per Govt./DME rules.
- C. For programme under the Faculty of Nursing Sciences, the admission process will be as per Govt. rules.
- D. For programme under the Faculty of Paramedical and Allied Health Sciences, the admission process will be as per Govt. rules.

Step-by-step Admission Process

- a. Candidate may apply for registration of admission through the university website <https://chirayuniversity.ac.in/> in various courses available for admission. The last date for applying is 30st June 2025 or till the last date as decided from time to time by the competent authorities of the university. Or, the candidates may opt to directly contact at the University Desk for the details.
- b. Candidate must fill out the application form available on the university website and pay Rs. 500/- as the application fee. Payment to be made through the following QR Code:



The candidates may also visit University campus in-person to get assistance for filling up the admission form during the office hours of university except on Sunday and holidays.

- c. If seats belonging to reserved category are vacant then they will be filled by unreserved category candidates.
- d. The applicants must provide their valid Email ID & Mobile No. which will be used for any kind of information to be provided.
- e. University has policy of Zero tolerance for ragging and indiscipline acts.
- f. Only complete filled application in all respects shall be considered for further process of admission. The documents needed at the time of application all requisite documents are as mentioned below:
 - i. Copy of Marksheet of 10th or Secondary examination
 - ii. Copy of Marksheet of 12th or Higher Secondary examination (if applicable)
 - iii. Copy of Marksheet of Graduation or equivalent examination (if applicable)
 - iv. Copy of Marksheet of Post-Graduation or equivalent examination (if applicable)
 - v. Copy of Aadhar Card
 - vi. Transfer or School/ College Leaving Certificate
 - vii. Migration Certificate
 - viii. Copy of relevant Category Certificate (if applicable)
 - ix. Copy of Domicile Certificate (Only for M.P. state candidates)
 - x. Income Certificate (if applicable)
 - xi. Admission Application Fee Receipt

Note: * In case of non-deposition of Fee by the specified last date “Selection for Admission” will be cancelled and seats will be considered available for admission for the other admission aspirants.

Preference will be given to candidate with CUET score.

In every round of counseling and admission, the Merit list shall be prepared from among the received applications after verification of fulfillment of minimum eligibility criteria for admission. The selected candidates as per the merit list shall report to the University campus for completing the remaining formality of admission and allotment to the admission committee along with the original documents as follows:

- a. Marksheet of 10th or Secondary examination
- b. Marksheet of 12th or Higher Secondary examination (if applicable)
- c. Marksheet of Graduation or equivalent examination (if applicable)
- d. Marksheet of Post- Graduation or equivalent examination (if applicable)
- e. Aadhar Card
- f. Transfer or School/ College Leaving Certificate
- g. Migration Certificate
- h. Relevant Category Certificate (if applicable)
- i. Domicile Certificate (Only for M.P. state candidates)
- j. Income Certificate (if applicable)

Note: Original Transfer or School/College Leaving Certificate and Migration Certificate/Original Gap Certificate and two self-attested sets of Xerox of aboveapplicable documents shall required for submitting at Constituent College/ Department of the University.

- h. The reservation policy for admission is as per applicable norms of Government of Madhya Pradesh.
- i. The candidate will have to pay either full or partial course fee at the time of reporting for admission at Constituent College or Teaching Department of University the following QR Code:



- j. Candidate must ensure to fill true and correct information. The admission of candidate shall be declared cancel at any time if any discrepancy found in the submitted data and submitted documents later in future.
- k. University can change admission guidance and procedure from time to time as per directive of State Govt. or concern Regulatory Body which may also be updated and displayed at the University

website. Candidates and/or parents are advised to visit University website regularly for the latest updated information.

- l. In case of cancellation of admission, candidates need to apply for cancellation of admission to the office of Principal or Dean of respective Constituent Colleges or Teaching Department before 10 days from the last date of admissions. Only tuition fees will be refunded after deduction of 10% and other fees will not be refunded.
- m. On recommendation of respective Regulatory Council or Madhya Pradesh Private University Regulatory Commission, University Admission Guidance and procedure 2025-26 can be updated accordingly, regarding approved seats-intake-capacity, admission dates and minimum eligibility criteria. The changes shall be updated regularly and may be available on University website from time to time.
- n. In case of any dispute, decision of Vice Chancellor, Chirayu University, Bhopal shall be final.
