Admission to the Ph.D. Programme for the Academic Session 2024-25

Applications are invited for admission to the Ph.D. Programme of the University on regular basis, in the **Faculty of Medicine, Faculty of Nursing Sciences** and **Faculty of Management Studies**. Admission of reserved category candidates will be done as per reservation policy of the State Government.

- Candidates seeking admission to the Ph.D. program shall have to possess requisite percentage of marks / grade point average / subjects/ specializations in qualifying examination.
- It is mandatory for foreign nationals/ NRI to submit AIU certificate along with other documents at the time of applying.
- One form will be considered for the selection process/ admission to ONE programme only.

The Application fee for the Ph.D. Programme (Non-refundable) is Rs. 1000/- for Unreserved/OBC/EWS/Transgender candidates and Rs. 500/- for SC/ST/PwD/Women

Eligibility criteria for admission to the Ph.D. Programme

The following are eligible to seek admission to the Ph.D. programme:

- (1) For Ph.D. under Faculty of Nursing Sciences and Faculty of Management Studies

Candidates who have completed: i. A 1-year/2-semester master's degree programme after a 4-year/8-semester bachelor's degree programme or a 2-year/4-semester master's degree programme after a 3-year bachelor's degree programme or qualifications declared equivalent to the master's degree by the corresponding statutory regulatory body, with at least 55% marks in aggregate or its equivalent grade in a point scale wherever grading system is followed or equivalent qualification from a foreign educational institution accredited by an assessment and accreditation agency which is approved, recognized or authorized by an authority, established or incorporated under a law in its home country or any other statutory authority in that country to assess, accredit or assure quality and standards of the educational institution. A relaxation of 5% marks or its equivalent grade may be allowed for those belonging to SC/ST/OBC (non-creamy layer)/Differently-Abled, Economically Weaker Section (EWS) and other categories of candidates as per the decision of the Commission from time to time. Provided that a candidate seeking admission after a 4-year/8-semester bachelor's degree programme should have a minimum of 75% marks in aggregate or its equivalent grade on a point scale wherever the grading system is followed. A relaxation of 5% marks or its equivalent grade may be allowed for those belonging to SC/ST/OBC (non-creamy layer)/Differently-Abled, Economically Weaker Section (EWS) and other categories of candidates as per the decision of the Commission from time to time.

(2) For Ph.D. under Faculty of Medicine

He/She shall have Postgraduate Qualification (P.G. Degree) in the concerned subject of Health Sciences or in the equivalent/ allied subject recognized as eligible by the concerned committee. The candidate(s) having D.N.B. shall also be considered eligible, if such candidate has published minimum two papers in Indexed Journal(s).

Note: Qualified and Eligible "Teacher candidates and all other "In-Service" candidates of Constituent College(s)/Faculties shall have to apply through proper channel.

Scheme of Entrance Test

The Entrance Test shall be of two hour duration (i.e., 90 minutes) and of 70 marks consisting of 70 objective type of questions. The Entrance Test will have two Sections, as mentioned here under:

Scoring Marks

- All objective type questions (four options with single correct answer) would carry one mark for each correct answer. More than one answer indicated against a question will be deemed as incorrect response. There will be no negative marking in objective type question paper.

- (ii) Qualifying the entrance test does not confirm the final selection, after qualifying the entrance test the candidate will have to appear for personal interview.
- (iii) Following candidates shall be eligible for appearing in Personal Interview (PI):
 - a. The entrance test qualified students.
 - b. The Candidates with valid selection from UGC-NET (Category-1,2,3 [ref: No.F.4-1(UGC-NET Review Committee)/2024(NET)/140648 dt. 27.03.2024])/ UGC-CSIR NET/ GATE / CEED / any other equivalent test conducted by GOI accredited agency (to be decided by the selection committee) are exempted from the entrance test and get preference in selection.
 - c. The candidates shall be required to discuss their research interests at the time of PI. Candidates are advised to bring proof of achievements/ projects/ dissertations/ publications in support of their candidature.

Details for online transfer

To pay the Ph.D. Application fee, the candidate has to go through an online portal named "**Qfix HDFC**". The bank has provided a QR code (mentioned below), by scanning that QR code, candidate can pay the fee after entering his or her basic details.

Note:

- The candidate must mention the nature of fee like "Ph.D. Entrance Test Fee" in the Purpose of Payment field.
- Cash payment will not be accepted.



Important Instructions:

- Candidates should read carefully the eligibility criteria as available in the Information Brochure before applying for the programme. If at any stage, it is found that candidates have furnished false or wrong data/information, their candidature/admission will be rejected/cancelled and no refund will be processed.
- The result of Ph.D. Entrance Test as declared by the University shall be final. There shall be no provision of rechecking of answer sheets. The University is competent to take all decisions on matters related to admission and the decision of the University shall be final.
- Further, the candidate qualified in the Entrance Test, does not mean that he/ she has been admitted to Ph.D. programme. The University does not give any guarantee that he / she will get admission for Ph.D. programme.
- No postal delay shall be entertained.
- **Candidates need to bring their original documents for verification at the time of admission.**
