

Important Notes:

1. The students are expected to complete the BCBR course in the first year. Passing of BCBR Examination is Mandatory Requirement to be eligible to appear for the University Final Examination.
2. Periodic Assessment of the Students should be carried out at the Constituent College Level as per the NMC Norms.
3. Students would need to complete total residency requirement of three years (i.e. thirty six months) as per the required "Duration of the MD/MS Programmes" including period of examination, to be eligible for the completion/award of the Degree.
4. Detailed Schedule for completing the requirement of various Academic Activities including Teaching, Sessional/Pre Univ. Exams, Continuous Assessments, GCP, BLS, ACLS, DRP, Research Publications (Students as first author) in the indexed journals etc. to be planned and completed at the Constituent College Level.
5. Research Advisory Committee/Scientific Committee and Institutional Ethics Committee are formed at College level in order to fulfill various requirements to review and to approve as per the norms.
